

Wednesday 20th December 1950 (a snippet about Mr Bardon of Bardon Park fame...!)

Charged in Perth Traffic Court today with having driven negligently a man was said by his counsel to have been driving for 43 years without an accident and to have been a member of the RAC 'for years.' Business manager William Frederick Stanley Bardon, of the corner of Fourth Ave. and View St, Maylands, pleaded not guilty. He was cautioned. Bardon's car collided with a tram at about 3.50 p.m. on September 21 at the junction of Barrack-St. and the Esplanade.

This month's talk will be given by one of our members, Terry Devereux, who has developed a passion for the history of the Old Peninsula Hotel on Railway Parade. It's a story worth repeating as this beautiful building was almost pulled down in 1976 to become a car park! Only community action prevented this happening and Terry will recount the events that took place to save the Peninsula Hotel.


